Statement of Faith

Our Guiding Principles

- ❖ **Life**
 - Human life, from fertilization to natural death, is sacred, and the right to life is fundamental to all other rights.
- ❖ **Marriage**
 - Marriage, as the union between one man and one woman, is an institution of God and a foundation of civil society.
- ❖ **Parental Authority**
 - Parents are ultimately responsible for the care and well-being of their children and therefore should be free from intrusive government involvement.
- ❖ **Constitutional Government**
 - The role and jurisdiction of government is clearly prescribed by our constitution and consequently should be restrained from excessive involvement in the lives of citizens.
- ❖ **Religious Liberty**
 - The right of conscience, and the right to practice faith according to personal beliefs are sacred and should not be infringed on or denied.
